



BOOK REVIEW:

MARTIAN VISION

Since the most recent film adaptation of Superman, I've been coming back to my old habit of reading comic-books! Specifically, I've been getting really into DC Comics' "Absolute" run, featuring reimaginings of characters like Batman, Superman, Wonder Woman, etc.

But of all the characters featured in this run of comics, probably the most interesting, most captivating book I've read from this series so far has got to be *Absolute: Martian Manhunter*.

Though I must admit, *Martian Manhunter* is a character I wouldn't have found myself reading all that much in the past, it's an excellently abstract, self-contained, story about an FBI Agents struggle to come to terms with the nature of evil and the human condition. For any former or current comic-readers (no matter your preference for DC, Marvel, or Independent Labels) it's something I cannot recommend enough.




